


Qualitative models

- The phenomenology approach to qualitative research studies various reactions to or perceptions of a particular phenomenon.
- The case study approach to qualitative research studies one individual, group, or program.

Preliminary Themes

- Attitude
- Purpose
- Effort
- Competency/Self Efficacy
- Ease of Use
- Benefits/Advantages
- Challenges/Disadvantages

Clustered Nodes by Coding Similarity



Findings

- 74% of respondents use Social Media sites
- —#1 Facebook, #2. Twitter, #3. LinkedIn
- 38% use online finance community
- Popular Finance (non brokerage) websites:
 - MSN Money, Mint.com, Yahoo finance
 - Motley Fool, Seeking Alpha, Zack's
 - Stocktwits

Interpretation/Learnings

- Collaboration and community appear to be main reason for using social media sites
- Social media empowers individuals by enabling digital conversations
- Limited use for serious trading
- Security and privacy concerns
- Concerns over benefits over risks

Next Steps...

- Use another coder for validation
- Further analysis of collected data (e.g. heat maps, clusters, reports)
- Use different sample for comparison
- Analyze data in conjunction with demographic information (Gen Y)
- Compare both groups
- Explore characteristics of successful apps/online finance social communities
