Response Rate: 66.67% (8 of 12)

- I learned how to apply different instructional design theories to actual business education courses.

Q24 - How will you use the knowledge you gained in future classes and/or in your chosen profession?

Response Rate: 75.00% (9 of 12)

- I intend to teach business education courses at the collegiate level. The course materials presented were absolutely relevant.
- I will develop better lesson plans
 - The techniques I learned will be utilized in my classroom. I like the way my professor asked for examples on how to apply the instructional strategies to the classroom and I got a lot of great ideas from other students in the class.

Q25 - Explain any positive changes you would like to see made to this course.

Response Rate: 58.33% (7 of 12)

- I think it is managed quite nicely.
- More interaction in discussion boards from professor.
- None, he did an awesome job with everything.

- There is a strong focus on discussion questions and I understand why but I think there should be other methods for understanding the material like mini projects that involve active learning. Also, this particular course was very short and there was a lot of information packed into the 4 weeks. I suggest making the summer session longer so that the material and assignments are not as overwhelming.
- I would not make any changes to this class.
- I thought the constraints of the posting times were a challenge. I took the online course because my schedule is limited.

Q26 - Comment specifically on the value of texts, class materials, assignments, and class activities.

Response Rate: 58.33% (7 of 12)

- The class activities were well-paced having enough time to complete the assignments without feeling rushed. The text used was a very good example of an engaging schoolbook for high school business education learners. Finding support for our posts teaches us not to rely on a single source of information and that it is important for us to look for our own answers. I really enjoyed the addition of the videos to help us navigate the library and CourseDen. They were very instructional and taught me several shortcuts that I had not previously known.
- The assignments were related to the readings and it opened my mind to research.
- The texts were helpful resources throughout the class.
- The text wasn't really necessary. All of the assignments required outside research; the book was only used to pick the topic. Topics could have been chosen without the book.
- The textbook was okay but it was very basic for understanding business concepts. There should be a complementary book on learning theories that explain the theories & models more in depth. Also, there should be additional resources (video, readings, etc) that explain how the theories & models can be linked to teaching business subjects.
- The texts that were available were very helpful in completing the assignments given.
- I would repeat what I said above here.

Q27 - Comment on the evaluation methods utilized—fairness, difficulty, ease, etc.

Response Rate: 66.67% (8 of 12)

- Very fair. Challenging. Enjoyed the communication between the classmates. Really enjoy the smaller class sizes so that there is more interaction with each of my classmates.
- His evaluation methods were fair and quick. He provided great feedback that had meaning. It wasn't like most teachers who just said good job; he actually added to the subject and provided open questions to have me think about other ideas I may not have thought about before.
- Dr. Hazari expects a lot, but I have gotten more from his classes than any others.

Q28 - Comment on the instructor's overall effectiveness as a teacher in his/her discipline.

Response Rate: 66.67% (8 of 12)

- Great job. I can truly say I have learned a lot and will be able to utilize these strategies and methods in my classroom.
 - Dr. Hazari is very knowledgeable on the material, is prompt and makes you think.
 - Dr. Hazari has a great understanding of the subject matter. He clearly articulates what is expected in the class and make sure that students get all of the help they need.
 - I haven't taken the final yet, so I'm not sure how effective his methods have been. I feel like I understand the material, but we will see after the final exam.
- Dr. Hazari is a great instructor and he provides very good questions and commentary to students that aid in understanding the material. This is a very demanding course and at times I did feel overwhelmed with the assignments and deadlines, but Dr. Hazari's active presence made me feel better about the course and pushed me to work hard and meet the necessary deadlines. Overall, I felt very comfortable in the class and I am happy to have had this chance to learn from him.
